some hope for an improved life. At that time, many "of our mountain kids" were schooled in huts high in the mountains that surround the city.

In 2004 our Club collected money to buy school desks for the kids with their local Club assisting with the purchase and delivery of the desks. In 2005, we gave the kids school supplies. The following year, we participated in a project to buy some 7,700 pairs of shoes for the kids who often had to travel long distances through rugged country to attend school. This last year we participated with our fellow Club in Bentonville-Bella Vista and District 6110 to purchase water tanks for the schools, resulting in 231 tanks being installed (see picture). These will allow the kids to have clean water throughout the year at their schools.

Thanks to George "Bear" Graen for much of this material and for bringing the needs of these kids to our Club.
