### **For Conference registration and info.....**

#### **humuhumu-nukunuku-ä-pua'a**

The name "humuhumu", the first part of the Hawaiian word used for all triggerfishes, may mean "to fit pieces together". This could refer to the way some species' color patterns resemble blocks of colors. The second part of the reef trigger's name is "nukunuku-ä-pua'a " and means "snout like a pig". To early Hawaiians, their behaviors of rooting through the sand or rocks for food and making grunting noises when handled represented piglike habits.
