Polio Plus and EREY

Wouldn't it be wonderful if 2010 is THE year that polio is eradicated in the World? Despite the efforts of Rotary and our associates, like the Gates Foundation, we still must keep up the fight through our contributions to the Rotary Foundation.

The first Rotary polio program started in 1979 as a project to immunize six million children in the Philippines. Think of the lives saved by the program that became Polio Plus in those 30 years.

There is a form in the December Rotarian magazine after page 58 to start an automatic debit for Polio Plus and/or the Rotary Foundation from a personal account.
