MOVING TO SAVOR

Rotary Club of Fayetteville is changing our meeting locations to ***Savor Restaurant*** at 2217 N College in Fayetteville.

Roy Rom reports on past meeting locations which have not been that many since 1921.

First meeting was held at the **Chamber of Commerce** building in 1921. After that meetings were held at the **Fire Station** at Block and Meadow Street until the fall of 1921 when the Club moved to the **Washington Hotel** (which was on the southwest corner of the Square) and stayed there until 1927, at which time it moved to the **Mountain Inn** and stayed there until 1940. In 1943 the Club moved back to the **Washington Hotel**, although in the interim it appears to have met at the **Blue Moon Cafe**. For a time, events and meetings were held at the **Uark Bowl** In 1962, the Club moved back to the Mountain Inn [AKA : **Down Town Motor Lodge**] and stayed there until 1972 when

meetings were moved to the **Holiday Inn**. By ballot vote, the Club moved to the **Hilton Inn** and the first meeting there was on 2/4/82. (The Hilton became the Radisson which became the Cosmopolitan.)

The old Fayrotales' accounts usually state the reasons for moves of venue were size of meeting rooms or failure to come to terms over cost and quality of meals. For the first 20 years of the Club's history meals were \$0.51 paid at the door.
